FundPHX Monthly Report January 2021

Executive Summary

FundPHX is an online budget tool designed to educate and engage the public in the city's annual budget process. The tool gives residents an opportunity to try their hand at balancing the city's \$1.4 billion General Fund operating budget, provide feedback on current funding levels and share community priorities with city staff.

Each month, Budget and Research staff provides a monthly report to the Phoenix City Council. Monthly reports are broken-out by Council district. Each district's report includes the number of submissions received, demographic information, the average change made to each spending/revenue category, the average difference between the existing budget and citizen submissions, and comments received. Comments received via FundPHX are responded to by Budget and Research staff as appropriate. In addition, a citywide summary provides the total number of submissions received through FundPHX and the total number of site views.

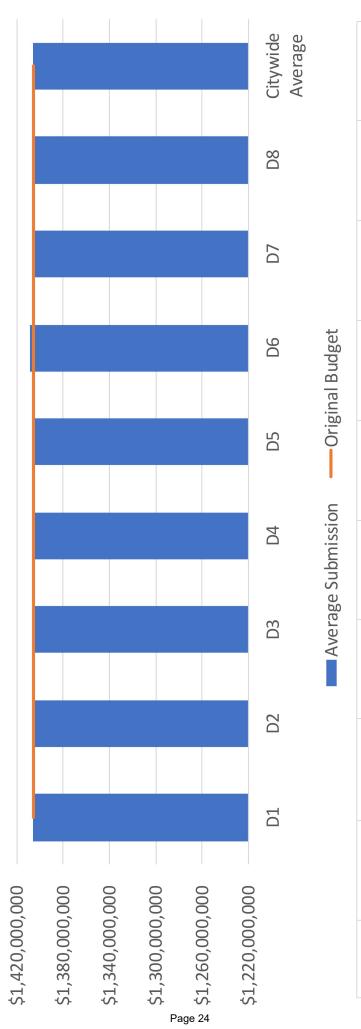

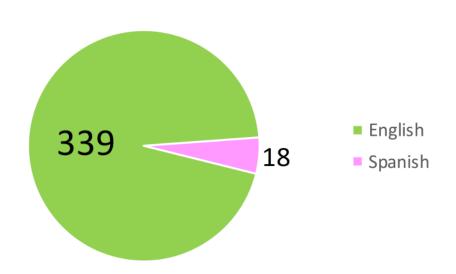

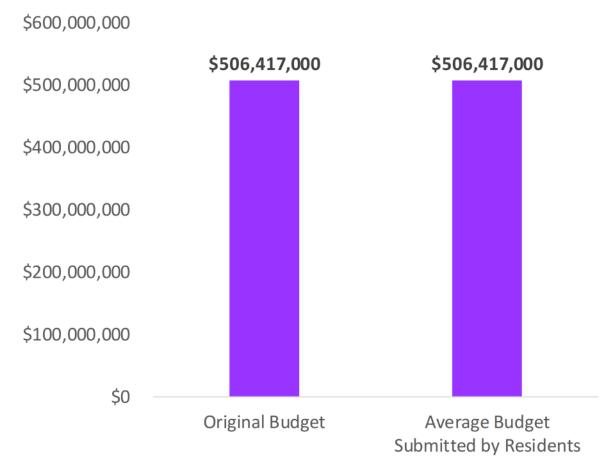
Comments:

- John Piersa stated that FundPHX does not provide sufficient information to determine the
 cost of fully reopening libraries for six days a week. He also stated that the Phoenix Police
 Department has been downsized over the years and should be funded to staff the
 department at the same level as a comparably-sized city, such as Philadelphia. Mr. Piersa
 requested that Police be funded to afford each officer a personally-maintained automatic
 rifle. He stated that additional funds for public libraries and Police should be transferred
 from light rail funding. (November 2020)

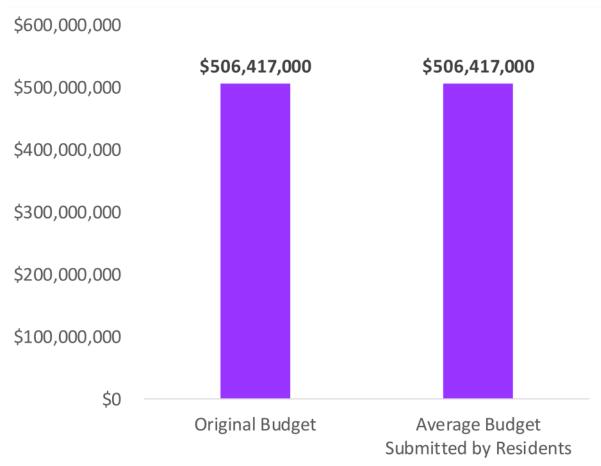
Comments:

- Benjamin Lewis stated that police violence is out of control. He stated that officers should be disarmed and held accountable for harm inflicted on the community. Mr. Lewis asked how an exponential increase to Human Services might reduce crime and the need for police. He also asked what the impact would be of an increased Neighborhood Services presence in the neighborhoods where crime is most prevalent. (January 2021)
- 2. Chelsea Hickok stated that the Police should be defunded to save Black and Brown lives, reduce the impact of one of the deadliest police forces in the nation, and to hold the Police accountable for institutional and systemic racism. She stated that defunding the Police would free-up greater resources for the community. Ms. Hickok stressed the importance of building-up the most vulnerable communities rather than resorting to incarceration. She also stated that the COVID-19 pandemic has increased evictions and foreclosures, which has intensified issues related to the unsheltered population. Ms. Hickok requested that the city provide more services for vulnerable populations. (January 2021)
