BACKGROUND / REFERENCES

A.R.S. §16-901(18) For a regular (scheduled) candidate election, the election cycle constitutes the two-year period beginning on the first day of the calendar quarter after the calendar quarter in which the city's or town's second, runoff or general election is scheduled and ending on the last day of the calendar quarter in which the city's or town's immediately following second/runoff election is scheduled.

A.R.S. §16-901(18)(b) For a special election, the election cycle means the period between the date of issuance of a proclamation or order calling the special election and the last day of the calendar quarter in which the special election is held.

ELECTION DATES

Regular Candidate Election Dates for Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8

- November 3, 2026 General Election
- March 9, 2027 Runoff Election (if no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast)

Regular Election Dates for Mayor and Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7

- November 5, 2024 Regular Election
- March 11, 2025 Runoff Election (if no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast)

Special Election Dates for District 7 Vacancy

- November 5, 2024 Special Vacancy Election
- March 11, 2025 Runoff Election (if no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast)

Regular Candidate Election Dates for Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8

- November 8, 2022 General Election
- March 14, 2023 Runoff Election (if no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast)
