MARKER CEREMONY



Please join the Phoenix Police Department to unveil a Historical Marker honoring Officer David "Star" Johnson who was killed in the line of duty on May 2, 1944.

This event will take place on May 2 at 9am near 2nd Street and Jefferson on the 80th anniversary of his death.

The ceremony will take place on the southside of the street near the east doors of the Footprint Center. The historical marker will be hung near the location where Officer Johnson was shot.

HSA REMINDERS

Did you know you can increase, decrease, or stop Health Spending Account (HSA) contributions at any time? Make any mid year HSA elections



changes through eCHRIS self-service. Simply navigate to the Benefits tile, click on the HSA with BCBS Saver's Choice tile, and proceed to make mid-year election changes.

Health Savings Accounts have a triple tax savings: HSA contributions are deducted pre-tax from your paycheck biweekly, you do not pay taxes when you spend your HSA dollars on qualified expenses, and once your account balance grows to over \$2,000, you do not pay taxes on the interest earned.

If enrolled in a HSA **and** a Flexible Spending Account (FSA), your FSA is automatically converted to a Limited Purpose FSA. You may only use funds from a Limited Purpose FSA on qualified dental and vision expenses.
