Police Communications Operator Pay and Hiring Range: \$24.93 per hour.

(Pay range is the entire compensation range for the position classification. Hiring range is an estimate of where you can receive an offer.)

Police Communications Operators answer calls from the public and communicate via radio with police officers regarding emergencies and non-emergencies. The person in this role works calmly with citizens and police officers using a multi-line telephone system, radio network panel, and Computer Aided Dispatch system to receive and process calls for police services. Police Communications Operators answer 911/crime stop phone calls and serve as radio dispatchers.

- The City of Phoenix is offering a \$7,500 hiring incentive.
- Employees who refer candidates to this position may be eligible for a referral incentive.
