

NEW EMPLOYEE TRANSIT CARD



Be on the lookout for a new Platinum Pass! Valley Metro is upgrading its fare card readers on all buses and at light rail stations. You will be issued a new pass in the next few weeks as part of this upgrade. Here's what you need to know to

continue riding with no interruption:

- ♦ Current passes will stop working after May 31.
- New passes will be distributed to current users by May 31.
- New Platinum Pass will come with instructions on how to use with new fare boxes.



provider, to get a list of employees who are eligible to be entered.




