#### **REQUIRED TRAINING**

As part of the City's efforts to be a leader in combatting human trafficking, all city employees are required to complete awareness training. CEASE Arizona (Cities Empowered Against Sexual Exploitation) has developed a self-paced curriculum in



PHXYou that needs to be completed by Jan. 31, 2025. With this training, employees will be able to understand what sex trafficking is, how to identify victims and places where trafficking occurs, and what to do if they suspect trafficking is happening.

The Municipal Court performs its responsibilities in a manner that maintains the public's trust while preserving and protecting individual rights guaranteed under the Constitution.

The Courtroom Specialist will assist the Judges and Hearing Officers by performing clerical work and coordinating the flow of cases and hearings. Job duties follow established routines, but unusual cases require judgment and discretion.
