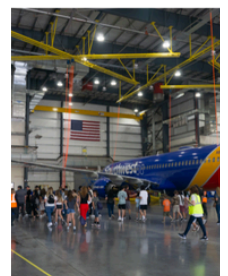
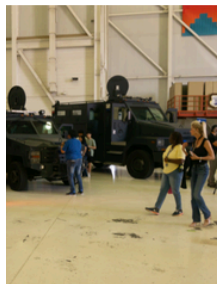
A Full Menu for “Bring Your Child...”

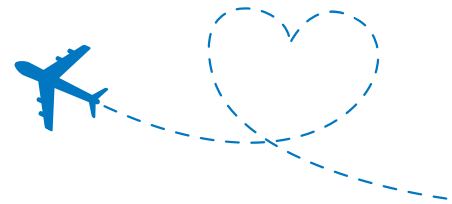
Dementia Friendly Air Travel Workshop

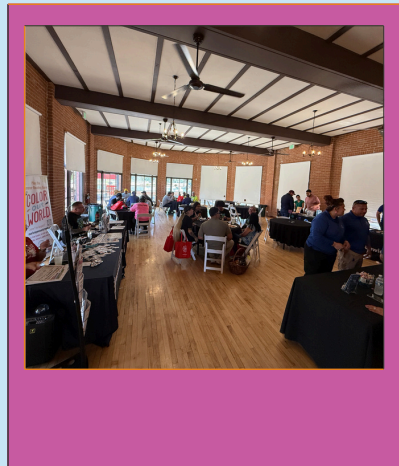

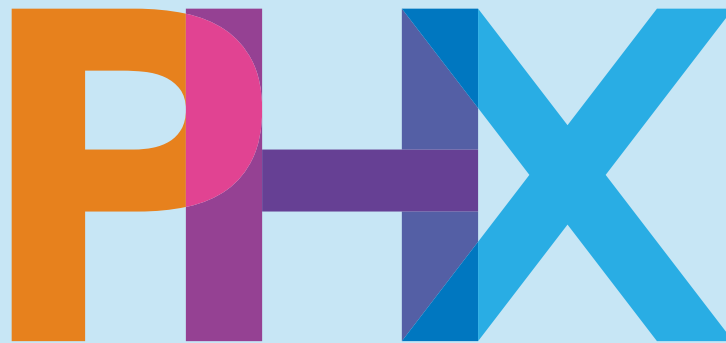
