Did you know 1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men have been victims of severe physical violence by an intimate partner during their lifetime?

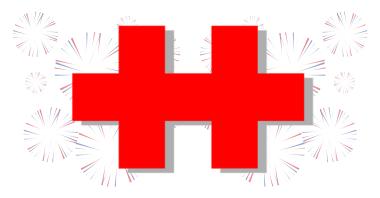


Abuse is not always physical. It's also emotional/psychological, financial, sexual, technological/digital, and can include stalking. Domestic violence can occur in any type of relationship.
