On Monday, Sept. 15, City of Phoenix employees enrolled in the Banner Aetna, BCBS PPO or Saver's Choice High-Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) can access the *MedImpact Consumer Portal* and download the mobile app at <u>medimpact.com</u>. Some features of the app include:
