# Traffic Alert for Sky Harbor Drivers

Now through Monday, Oct. 6, eastbound Sky Harbor Boulevard near Terminal 3 will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. for construction. For anyone heading in and out of Sky Harbor for fall break, please plan for heavy traffic and delays.

Drivers are being urged to enter from the east and encouraged to use the free 24/7 PHX Sky Train® at 24th or 44th Street to avoid congestion.
