Gated Alley Program Officially Expanded



For years, my council team and I have personally heard from neighbors about the problems in their alleys that are plagued with illegal dumping, vandalism, and blight. Since 2020, my Council team and I have worked to support residents throughout District 5 to gate fifteen alley segments during the pilot program, and I have advocated for the expansion of the Gated Alley Program. In this year's Budget Fiscal Year 22-23, it includes over \$600,000 for 45 new alley segments and a new position.

On September 7th, the Phoenix City Council unanimously approved the Gated Alley Program Implementation, and staff is currently processing forms already submitted by residents. This new process has empowered many new resident leaders to work with our office to begin addressing other

neighborhood issues. For these neighbors, this program is about more than putting a gate in an alley. It is about the residents taking back control of their neighborhoods to provide a safe and clean environment for their families.

The Aviation Department was recently recognized by Airports Council International with Level 4 carbon accreditation, for our commitment to

reducing the environmental impact of airport. Phoenix Sky Harbor received the Level 4 "Transformation" rating from Airport Carbon Accreditation.

We are currently the only airport in the U.S. to have achieved the Transformation certification, and only one of three airports in the U.S to have achieved the Level 4/4+ rating tier.
