Hotwork Program and Welding Permit Application

- Welding & Hotwork F200 \$150** – Select this permit for one-time use or for businesses with not more than 2 employees conducting welding operations.

Operations including cutting, welding, Thermite welding, brazing, soldering, grinding, thermal spraying, thawing pipe, installation of torch-applied roof systems or operation involving open flame torches or similar activity.

- Hotwork Program F201 \$300** – Select this permit when there are more than 2 employees conducting welding operations.

When *approved*, the *fire code official* shall issue a permit to carry out a hot work program. This program allows *approved* personnel to regulate their facility's hot work operations. The *approved* personnel shall be trained in the fire safety aspects denoted in this chapter and shall be responsible for issuing permits requiring compliance with the requirements found in Chapter 35 of the Phoenix Fire Code. These permits shall be issued only to their employees or hot work operations under their supervision.
