NEW LINEAR PARK

(District 8)

- Existing Edison Park (901 N. 19th St.) to expand south by approx. five acres
- New approx. 3.5-acre Linear Park (east side of 19th St. from Villa to Polk streets)
- Pedestrian connections to Harmony at the Park Festival Streets
- Rezoned to Walkable Urban Code
- \$12M Investment
- Funded by City of Phoenix and HUD CDBG and Choice Neighborhoods

Background Details:

- \$42.5M Edison-Eastlake Choice Neighborhoods Grant from U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- Located on former A.L. Krohn Homes and Frank Luke Homes public housing sites
- City Parks and Recreation Department to maintain both parks

Anticipated Construction Start-Completion Timelines:

- Edison Park: October 2025-August 2026
- Linear Park: October 2025-August 2026
- Ribbon cutting event: Fall/Winter 2026
