Citizen Participation Plan Amendment - 2021

HUD Funding Sources

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Provides resources to address housing and community development needs that benefit low- and moderate-income individuals

HOME Investment Partnership (HOME)

Creates housing opportunities for low-income households

Federal Programs

Housing Opportunities for Persons with HIV/AIDS (HOPWA)

Provides housing assistance and related support services to those living with HIV/AIDS


Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)

Assists individuals and families to regain permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis or homelessness

Overview of the Consolidated Plan

The Consolidated Plan:


- Assists the City in determining community needs for low- to moderate-income households
- Begins a community-wide dialogue to determine community needs
- Outlines strategy for addressing those needs with federal funds

Overview of Annual Action Plan




The Annual Action Plan:

- Created every year
- Addresses the priority needs and specific goals identified by the Consolidated Plan
- Summarizes the actions and activities that will be funded in that fiscal year

Overview of Citizen Participation Plan

The Citizen Participation Plan:

- Adopted in 1996
- Encourages citizen participation in the development and implementation of the Assessment of Fair Housing (AFH), the Consolidated Plan (CP) and Annual Action Plan (AAP)



Components of Citizen Participation Plan

4 Major CPP Components:

- Development of the AFH, CP and AAP
- Public Hearings, Notice & Outreach
- Amendments and Substantial Amendments
- Public Comment

Citizen Participation Plan Major Changes

Summary of amendments proposed:

- Addition of Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3)
- Clarifying Amendments vs. Substantial Amendments
- Clarifying Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan
- Clarifying the Citizen Participation Plan amendment process
- Other language changes to align with HUD guidance and document current processes
