Who needs a City of Phoenix Street Vending License?

Anyone selling, offering, or displaying items while in the street or public roadway.

Where can I apply for a license and how much does it cost?

You may apply for a Street Vending License at the City of Phoenix License Services located at Phoenix City Hall, 200 W. Washington St. 10th Floor. The application fee is \$130.00 and the license is \$30.00. You can contact License Services at (602) 262-4638.

How long does the street vending license remain valid?

The City of Phoenix Street Vending License expires at the end of the fiscal year in which it was issued.

If I'm selling food, do I need any other licenses?

Yes, all food vendors must have a Maricopa County Health Department Food Handlers Permit.

If I have my City of Phoenix Street Vending License, can I operate on any street in the City of Phoenix?

No, a vendor may not sell merchandise from his vehicle or stand within 600 ft. of any school ground between the hours of 7:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. In addition, street vending in the Downtown Vending District is prohibited.

Can I operate in City parks?

No, street vending is prohibited inside City of Phoenix parks and on streets abutting a City of Phoenix park that is within 150 ft. of a lawfully established park concession.
