


Public Health & Green Spaces



Parks Master Plan




- The Parks and Recreation Department in partnership with professional consultants will develop a citywide Parks Master Plan as a policy document that will guide the direction of recreation facilities, programs and services for the next 10 years and beyond.

- **Master Plan Scope**

The Master Plan will include several key focus areas through a process of:

- Evaluating and Taking Inventory of existing parks, recreation programming and facilities with an emphasis on water conservation strategies and Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED).
- Assessing community demographics and recreation trends to ensure delivery of quality programs and services equitably across the city.
- Identifying how the department prioritizes funding.

Future Efforts

- Maryvale Pool Renovation
 - The project is part of the city's 2023 GO Bond Program.
 - What's being done? Regional pool: A 25-meter lap pool with dive boards, zero depth entry, and a swimming lesson area
 - Accessibility: The new facilities will meet or exceed ADA requirements
 - Play features: Interactive water play area and enhanced play features
 - Why is this being done? To address the city's deteriorating pools problem. To provide a regional pool with amenities for residents of all ages
- Old Palo Verde Library Building
 - Scheduled demolition of building in Spring 2025.
 - New amenity to be determined.


Our Challenge / Nuestro desafío

43 out of 55 food deserts in Maricopa County are located within the City of Phoenix.






