

Plumbing, Occupant Load Interpretation

Code/Section	2018 IBC, Sections 1004.5, Exception; Section 2902.1
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Issue:

Develop a policy and procedure for using the exception to IBC section 1004.5 for the purpose of determining minimum plumbing fixtures per IBC section 2902.1.

Interpretation:

As an exception to the calculation method found in IBC section 1004.5, the actual number of occupants for a space may be used, as approved by the Building Official. In order to use this exception, statistical data must be submitted by the owner of the space.

The owner must submit a letter requesting the actual occupant load to be permitted for the plumbing design occupant load. The following items must be met with the letter and architectural cover sheet for reduced plumbing fixtures:

If accepted, the permit work description shall state that the actual occupant load, per the owner, is being lumbing only, per their letter dated The letter shall be scanned for with the building permit.

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
