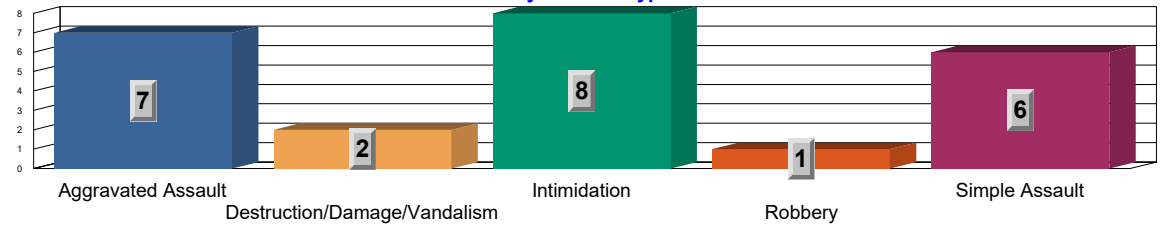

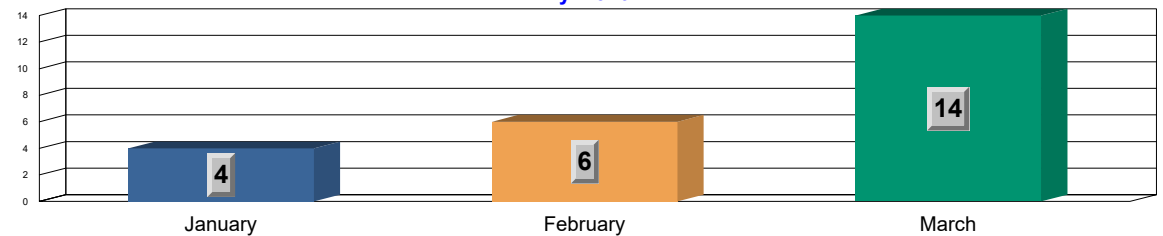

This report is based solely on Hate Crime Incident Reports received from the Bias Crime Unit and verified according to federal reporting guidelines. Because of the difficulty of ascertaining the offender's subjective motivation, bias is to be reported only if the investigation reveals sufficient information to lead a reasonable and prudent person to conclude that the offender's actions were motivated, in whole or in part, by bias. The mere fact that the offender is biased against the victim's race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, and/or ethnicity/national origin does not mean that a hate crime was involved. Rather, the offender's criminal act must have been motivated, in whole or in part, by his/her bias. Not all Bias Crime incidents are reported to the Bias Crimes Detail. Counts may change as additional reports are finalized and/or reclassified. Any reports with missing or incomplete information are not included.
