

## What is it?

This June and July, the Phoenix Police Department will present the Phoenix Police Youth Experience to introduce teens to the world of law enforcement.

This program will acquaint participants, 7th and 8th grade, to the basic inner workings of the police department and the roles and responsibilities of police officers and civilian staff. It will also encourage the building of friendships while networking with other participants and staff.

On the final day, participants will work with a police officer to investigate a crime scene, set up especially for them.

All participants will receive a t-shirt and a certificate upon completion of the week's activities. This program is FREE.
