Early Evening Shooting Sends Two Teens to the Hospital

(April 22, 2025) - Detectives are investigating a shooting that resulted in two teenagers at the hospital and an outstanding suspect.

On April 21, 2025, around 5:50 p.m., officers were called to a shooting by a park near 23rd Avenue and Minnezona Avenue. When officers arrived, they found a male and a female injured by gunfire. The fire department responded and transported both teenagers to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. Officers were told the suspect left the area before police arrived.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. They spoke to witnesses, collected evidence, and searched for surveillance footage. Currently, investigators are processing the evidence and searching for a suspect in this shooting. Any additional information remains part of an ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is encouraged to call Phoenix police or Silent Witness, if they wish to remain anonymous.
