Traffic Fatality in North Phoenix

(March 19, 2025) Detectives are investigating a motorcycle collision that left a man dead.

On March 19, 2025, around 1:15 p.m., officers responded to a vehicle collision near the 14000 block of North Cave Creek Road. When officers arrived, they found a man lying on the roadway with obvious signs of trauma. The fire department responded and determined the man, later identified as 58-year-old Remus Rizea, died from his injuries on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests Rizea was riding on a three-wheeled motorcycle on private property when he lost control and collided with a raised curb. Rizea was ejected off of the motorcycle and landed on Cave Creek Road. The investigation remains active and any additional information remains part of an ongoing investigation.
