The suspect in this shooting, identified as 23-year-old David William Jones, was released from medical care and subsequently booked on multiple charges related to this investigation. These charges include attempt murder and aggravated assault. The victim in the shooting remains hospitalized. This is continues to be an ongoing investigation.

Joint Police Response to Shooting in West Phoenix

(November 9, 2025) Phoenix Police Officers responded to a shooting incident late Friday morning and found an adult male victim suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The suspect was located a short time later with a self-inflicted gunshot wound and was also taken to the hospital.

Around 10:46 a.m., on November 7, 2025, officers responded to an apartment complex for a shooting incident near 2500 South 99th Avenue. Officers located a 28-year-old victim suffering from serious injuries consistent with a gunshot wound. The victim was taken to a local hospital with serious life-threatening injuries. During the initial investigation, a second 9-1-1 call was dispatched advising officers of a man suffering from a gunshot wound near 99th Avenue and Van Buren, in Tolleson, Arizona. Officers from both Phoenix and Tolleson responded and confirmed the 23-year-old man was related to the earlier shooting in Phoenix. He was assessed by Phoenix Fire personnel and taken to the hospital with serious life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to the scene and learned the suspect made forced entry into the victim's residence near 2500 South 99th Avenue and confronted the victim with a gun. The suspect shot the victim multiple times before turning the gun on himself. Surviving the self-inflicted shooting, the suspect left the area driving to 99th Avenue and Van Buren Street where he was later contacted by

police and taken to the hospital. Once released from the hospital, the suspect will be booked into jail and an updated media advisory will be sent out.
