Motorcycle Rider Dies After North Phoenix Collision

(June 19, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating late evening collision that left a man dead.

On June 18, 2025, around 7:25 p.m., officers in the area of Canterbury Drive and Thunderbird Road observed a motorcycle rider violating multiple traffic laws, to include speeding. Officers were unable to catch up to the motorcycle to conduct a traffic stop. The motorcycle traveled north on Canterbury Drive when it lost control and was involved in a collision with another vehicle. The collision resulted in the motorcycle being engulfed in flames. When officers arrived at the collision scene, they located the adult male motorcycle rider, identified as 30-year-old Obed Manriquez Jr. Manriquez Jr. did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene. The other vehicle involved in the collision remained on scene and no other injuries resulted from the collision.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
