Pedestrian Dies After Being Struck By Vehicle

(October 2, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a hit and run collision that left a man dead.

On October 2, 2025, around 7:10 p.m., officers responded to the area of 35th Avenue and Holly Street regarding collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult male pedestrian, later identified as 58-year-old Gilbert Campas, with serious injuries. Campas was transported to a nearby hospital, but he did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The vehicle involved took off from the scene after the collision and has not yet been located.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. The preliminary investigation indicates that Campas was crossing 35th Avenue when he was struck by the vehicle involved. The vehicle that left the scene is described as light-colored pickup truck. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
