Man Dies Day After Hit and Run Collision

(October 20, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a hit and run collision that left a man dead.

On October 19, 2025, around 8:45 a.m., officers responded to the area of 3rd Avenue and Bell Road regarding collision involving a motorcycle. When officers arrived, they located the adult male motorcycle rider, identified as 30-year-old Heaven Lucas Conner, with serious injuries. Conner was transported to a nearby hospital with life-threatening injuries. Officers on scene learned that the other vehicle involved in the collision left the area prior to police arrival. This vehicle was described as a red passenger car.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. The preliminary investigation indicates that Conner was traveling westbound on Bell Road, as was the red passenger vehicle. The vehicle abruptly pulled in front of the motorcycle driven by Conner, causing the collision. The red passenger vehicle left the area right after the collision.

On October 20, 2025, Conner succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case. Additional details related to this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation.
