One Dead After Dirt Bike Collision with Vehicle

(June 26, 2025) Detectives are investigating a fatal collision that happened in south Phoenix involving a dirt bike and vehicle, leaving one woman dead.

Just before 10:00 pm, officers responded to a collision involving a dirt bike and truck in the area of 16th Street and Southern Avenue. As officers began to arrive on the scene, they located an adult female, later identified as 19-year-old Britney Vasquez Gomez, in critical condition. The Phoenix Fire Department arrived on the scene and transported Gomez to a nearby hospital, where she later died at the hospital. The adult male driver of the dirt bike was also located and transported to a nearby hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. The adult male driver of the truck remained on the scene and did not sustain injuries.

Detectives responded to assume the investigation and process the scene. Preliminary information suggests Gomez was the passenger of the dirt bike traveling southbound on 16th Street when it collided with the truck who was traveling northbound on 16th Street and turning left into a private drive. The driver of the dirt bike did not show signs of impairment. The adult male driver of the truck involved was evaluated for impairment and was processed for DUI. Charging decisions will not be determined until the conclusion of the investigation. Additional information remains a part of the ongoing investigation.
