Morning Shooting Leaves Woman Dead

(August 1, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a North Phoenix shooting that claimed the life of a woman.

On August 1, 2025 at around 6:10 a.m., officers responded to the area of 40th Street and Meadow Drive regarding a shooting. When officers arrived, they located an adult female, identified as 45-year-old Alma Suchilt with multiple gunshot wounds. Suchilt was taken to the hospital with life-threatening injuries, but she did not survive and was pronounced deceased.

The initial officers on scene gathered crucial information leading to a suspect being identified as 47-year-old Jonathan Llamas Cisneros. Llamas Cisneros was tracked to the Interstate 8 and was found to be traveling south towards Gila Bend. A traffic stop was attempted, but Llamas Cisneros failed to comply and took off from officers. With the assistance of multiple agencies, to include the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office, Department of Public Safety, Border Patrol, and the Arizona Department of Transportation, Llamas Cisneros was eventually stopped and arrested. Evidence linking Llamas Cisneros to the murder was found at the time of his arrest.

Homicide detectives responded to the original scene to assume the investigation. After being interviewed, Llamas Cisneros was booked on multiple charges related to the investigation to include murder and felony flight. This case is considered to be a domestic violence incident as Suchilt and Llamas Cisneros have a child in common. Additional details related to this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation.
