Detectives Seek Public's Help in Identifying Person of Interest

Since the date of this homicide, detectives have worked tirelessly attempting to identify and apprehend the suspects responsible for the murder of 16-year-old Trey Bomelyn. To date, three suspects have been arrested and charged in connection to the investigation. Each of the teen suspects has been charged with murder, and all have been remanded and charged in adult court.

In addition to this update, the Phoenix Police Department is releasing a photograph of a person of interest. This person is believed to have information related to this investigation and detectives are seeking to identify and interview this person. If anyone has information about this person, we encourage you to contact the Phoenix Police Department or Silent Witness to remain anonymous.

This remains an active investigation.

Media partners, for specifics about this case and the booking information for the arrested suspects, you will need to reach out to the Maricopa County Attorney's Office. Because the suspects were all originally booked as juveniles prior to being formally charged as adults, **traditional booking numbers are not available.**

Three Teens Shot Leaving One Dead

(October 3, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a shooting that left one teen male dead.

On October 2, 2025, at around 7:43 pm, officers responded to the area of 37th Street and La Salle Street regarding a shooting. Once officers arrived on the scene, they located two juvenile teen males with gunshot wounds. Both juveniles were transported to a nearby hospital; one sustained non-life-threatening injuries, and the other was in critical condition and later died.

A third juvenile male was self-transported to the same hospital with a non-life-threatening gunshot wound.

Homicide detectives and Night detectives responded to assume the investigation and begin processing the scene. Detectives are still working on piecing together what led to the three teens being shot. Additional details related to this incident remain a part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is encouraged to call SILENT WITNESS at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO).
