Overnight Shooting Leaves Teen Male in Critical Condition

(April 2, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an overnight shooting that left one teenage male in critical condition and left a woman in the hospital.

On April 1, 2025, around 8:00 p.m., officers responded to the area of 35th Avenue and Baseline Road regarding a shooting. When officers arrived, they located a teenage male with at least one life-threatening gunshot wound in the parking lot. The teen male was transported to a nearby hospital where he remains in critical condition.

During the investigation, officers received information from a nearby hospital of a reported walk-in with a non-life-threatening gunshot wound. Officers responded and contacted the adult female who said she was there at the time of the shooting. The female was treated and eventually released.

Detectives responded to assume the investigation. Additional details related to this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip.
