### **Two Arrested in Violent Shooting That Left a Man Dead**

#### **UPDATE: May 14, 2025**

Detectives have arrested and charged two suspects with the murder of 30-year-old Jeremy Carra, which happened on August 25, 2024. The following month detectives identified, interviewed and arrested 24-year-old Zacariah Garcez. During the investigation detectives were able to identify 19-year-old Jordan Wren as a second suspect. Over the past several months, attempts to locate Wren were unsuccessful. On May 13, 2025, Wren was identified by patrol officers in Phoenix during a traffic stop. The officers informed investigators of his detention and he was arrested and transported to police headquarters. After speaking with detectives, Wren was booked into jail for 2nd Degree murder and Aggravated Assault under MCSO booking number G178770.

### **Two Injured, One Dead in South Phoenix Shooting**

(August 25, 2024) Two victims have been hospitalized and one pronounced deceased after officers responded to a shooting in south Phoenix early Saturday morning.

At about 3:00 a.m., officers were called to a shooting incident at 10200 South 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue. As officers got to the area, they found three adult victims all suffering from gunshot wounds. All victims were taken to the hospital with life-threatening injuries. While receiving treatment at the hospital one of the

adult male victims was not able to survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The second adult male victim and adult female victim were listed in stable condition and are recovering at the hospital.

Detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation. Preliminary information was learned that the suspects involved drove away from the scene north on 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
