UPDATE: November 23, 2025

The suspect in this investigation, identified as 28-year-old Tyrone Dee Chilly, was released from medical care. He was interviewed about the incident and then was booked into jail on multiple charges related to the incident. The charges included two counts of murder and multiple charges of aggravated assault and endangerment.

There are no further updates in this case at this time. This remains an ongoing investigation, however no other potential suspects are believed to be involved.

Second Victim Dies After Shooting

The adult male victim that passed away on scene has been identified as 30-year-old Quincy Jay Polk. One of the juvenile female victims that was transported to the hospital has unfortunately passed away due to her injuries. This child has been identified as 8-year-old Envy Cardenas. There are no updates to the others involved in this incident.

In the abundance of respect for the victims involved, the relationship between the listed victims will not be released.

This remains an active and ongoing investigation.

South Side Shooting Leaves One Dead and Three Hospitalized

(November 22, 2025) Homicide detectives are investigating a shooting that left one man dead and three hospitalized. Two of the victims have been identified as young children, one in extreme critical condition and the other in stable condition.

Patrol officers responded to a shooting call in the area of 19th Avenue and Baseline Road at about 2:45 p.m. Saturday afternoon, after a physical fight escalated to a fatal shooting. As officers got to the scene, an adult male was detained and identified as the driver of a passenger car who was involved in the shooting. Officers also located five victims that were in an SUV when the shooting occurred. Phoenix Fire responded to the scene and pronounced the adult male driver of the SUV deceased. An adult female in the SUV sustained at least one gunshot wound and was taken to the hospital in critical condition. Three young children were in the back seat of the SUV. Two of them receiving gunshot wounds. One of the children was taken to the hospital in extremely critical condition and the other received non-life threatening injures. The third child was not struck by gunfire and was taken to the hospital with the other victims.

Homicide detectives responded and took over the investigation. Initial investigation suggests the suspect and victims were about to pull out of the parking lot just north of 7550 South 19th Avenue at which time a physical fight began. The parties separated and went back to their vehicles. At this point, the suspect removed a gun and shot several rounds at the victim's vehicle striking four of the victims. Witnesses did report seeing the adult female victim take out her own gun and shoot back at the suspect. The suspect was later taken to the hospital for unrelated health issues and was admitted for overnight care.

Additional information concerning this incident is part of an ongoing investigation. Detectives are asking anyone who may have information, videos or photographs to call police to help understand what led to this violent and tragic incident.
