(April 28, 2025) — The Phoenix Police Department is excited to announce the launch of Smart Notifications for 1st Responders. This voluntary program allows community members living in the City of Phoenix to provide additional information to officers when responding to incidents at their residence.

Smart Notifications creates a pathway to provide information regarding mental health concerns, cognitive issues, communication methods, or other important information about themselves or those at the address where officers are responding.
