Single Vehicle Construction Site Collision Leaves Man Dead

(January 6, 2025) Detectives are investigating a collision that left a man dead Saturday afternoon.

On January 4, 2025, just before 2:00 p.m., officers responded to an injured person call at a construction site near 7th Street and Sonoran Desert Drive. When officers arrived, they were met by construction site employees and led to an area on the site. Officers then found a man, later identified as 18-year-old Omar Marino Alonso, on the ground with obvious signs of trauma and a water truck with significant damage nearby. The fire department responded and determined Marino Alonso had died on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests Marino Alonso was driving the water truck down a hill, when he lost control of the truck and caused it to roll over. Marino Alonso was ejected and suffered significant injuries. Speed appears to be a factor in this collision. Investigators continue to process the evidence collected on scene.

Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
