## **Hit and Run Collision Leaves Pedestrian Dead**

(February 26, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an early evening collision that left a pedestrian dead.

On February 26, 2025, around 6:00 p.m., officers responded to the area of 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Maricopa Street regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult female pedestrian with serious injuries. The woman was transported to a nearby hospital where she did not survive her injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the vehicle involved was westbound on Maricopa Street when it struck the pedestrian who was in the roadway. The vehicle took off from the area prior to police arrival. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case.
