Evening Hours Collision Leaves Pedestrian Dead

(February 7, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a west valley collision that left a pedestrian dead.

On February 7, 2025, around 6:30 p.m., officers responded to the area of 51st Avenue and Van Buren Street regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult female pedestrian with serious injuries. The woman was transported to a nearby hospital where she did not survive her injuries and was pronounced deceased. The vehicle involved in the collision remained on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the woman was crossing Van Buren Street just east of the intersection when she was struck by the vehicle involved, which was traveling eastbound. Impairment is not believed to be a factor in the collision. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
