Fatal Crash in a West Phoenix Work Zone

(March 6, 2025) Detectives investigate a fatal crash involving a work truck accessing a sewer line near 32nd Avenue and Grand Avenue late Tuesday night.

Just before 11:00 p.m., on Tuesday night officers were called to a crash involving a truck and a box style work truck in the area of 3200 West Grand Avenue. Once on scene, patrol officers found an adult male victim inside the work truck suffering from serious injuries. Phoenix Fire responded to the scene and took him to a nearby hospital where he was not able to overcome his injuries and died. The truck involved stayed on scene as the driver was provided medical care by The Phoenix Fire Department. The adult male driver was taken to the hospital where officers noticed signs of intoxication. The man was admitted into the hospital with serious but non-life-threatening injuries and processed for DUI.

Detectives responded to the scene and learned that the box style work truck was stopped in the roadway with emergency cones around the designated work area when the suspects truck crashed into the work truck. The victim later identified as 54-year-old Yusuf Munir was in the back of the work truck when the collision happened. Charging decision will not be determined until after the investigation is completed.
