## Operation Double Down News Conference

**DATE:** Thursday, February 20, 2025  
**TIME:** 11:00 a.m. start time, arrival should be before with time to setup  
**EVENT:** Press Conference detailing Operation Double Down  
**LOCATION:** Phoenix Police Property Annex, 100 E. Elwood Street, Phoenix

The Phoenix Police Department will be hosting a news conference to detail Operation Double Down, a multi-agency coordinated investigation to identify and arrest individuals involved in a large-scale drug operation. The results of this investigation led to the arrest of over 20 individuals and the seizure of large quantities of illegal drugs, money, firearms, and vehicles, by the partners involved, much of which will be displayed at the news conference.

Representatives from various law enforcement agencies will be present at the news conference to include:

- Arizona Attorney General's Office
- Phoenix Police Department
- Phoenix Division of the Drug Enforcement Bureau
- Arizona HIDTA
