# **Eligibility Requirements**

- Reimbursable Activities must be:
  - Grant-eligible (Circular 9070.1G)
  - Allowable and Reasonable (OMB Circular A-122)
  - Listed in Grant Application
  - Approved by 5310 MAG Committee Process
  - Indirect Costs must include an approved cost allocation plan (CAP).



### **Allowable Costs**

- Must be a composition of total costs. Sum of direct, indirect (allocable) minus credits
- Be reasonable
- Be consistent with policies, regulations
- In accordance with GAAP principles
- Not be included to meet matching requirements of any other federally financed program
- Be adequately documented
- Refer to Selected Items of Cost list in OMB A-122 for allowable and unallowable costs



#### Reimbursements

- Submit timely at minimum quarterly
- Documentation
  - Provide "lead sheet" or detailed list of all expenditures for reimbursement
  - Time sheets for salaries
  - Invoices and proof of payment
  - Itemized receipts for purchases



## **Grant Reporting**

#### Quarterly Milestone Progress Reports

- Sufficient project status detail narrative, including efforts to move project forward if delays
- Update estimated milestone completion dates

#### Quarterly Federal Financial Reports

- Accrued expenses expenses incurred and not yet paid, or not yet reimbursed by grant
- Fixed Asset Report FTA-Funded Fixed Assets
  - Annual Reporting Vehicles
    - 1. Insurance
    - 2. Vehicle Maintenance Records
  - Upon Disposal
    - 1. Date Removed from Service
    - 2. Disposal Date
    - 3. Net Disposal Proceeds



## **Grant Close-Out**

- Timely Implementation and Completion of Projects
- Timely Draw Down of Federal Funds
- Reallocation of Project Savings/Remaining Funds
- Grant Inactivity May Jeopardize Remaining FTA Funds
