


20th Street: Glendale/Lincoln to Grand Canal – Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project



- This corridor is ranked the 4th highest priority in the City of Phoenix Bicycle Master Plan.
- The 20th Street corridor is located approximately a quarter mile east of SR-51, and provides access to four grade separated non-motorized passes of the freeway at the Grand Canal, Campbell Avenue, Maryland Avenue, and the Arizona Canal.
- Twentieth Street is a two and four lane roadway that can provide a safe, easy, low-stress rideable and walkable thoroughfare to connect residents to schools, employment, restaurants and shopping (i.e. Town and Country Shopping Center, Camelback Colonnade Center), and major bus routes.
- The 3.75 mile long corridor encompasses 20th Street between the Grand Canal and Glendale Avenue; and a connection to the Piestewa Peak on either Glendale Avenue between 20th Street and Squaw Peak Drive or along Ocotillo Road.
