

Neighborhood Notification: Bicycle Improvements on 40th Street from Air Lane to Washington Street

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network. Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

About the Improvements

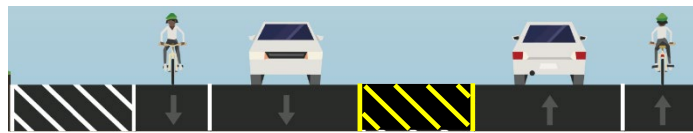
Where: 40th Street from Air Lane to Washington Street

What: Where there is enough space on the roadway, existing bike lanes will be widened, and buffers will be added to existing bike lanes. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. The project does not remove or add parking.

When: Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is scheduled for spring 2025 and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

Why: Buffered bike lanes add space between people driving and people walking or biking for increased protection from vehicles, improved safety and added comfort. The slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the buffered bike lanes will help to guide cars and deter speeding.

Medians At Either Side of Railroad Track

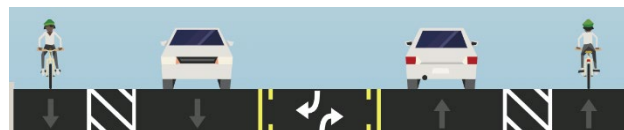

North Side of Railroad Track to North of Madison Street

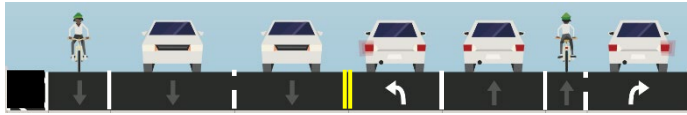


Current Travel Lanes

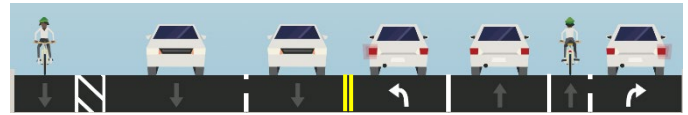


Proposed Travel Lanes
