

PROJECT UPDATE – April 2025 Campbell Avenue from 59th Avenue to 51st Avenue

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of Campbell Avenue from 59th Avenue to 51st Avenue.

In September 2024, the department hosted a public meeting to discuss a potential option for restriping Campbell Avenue after a slurry seal treatment. Additional outreach occurred in 2024 and early 2025. The input gathered from that outreach effort and engineering judgment were taken into consideration as department staff selected the final design.

PROJECT DETAILS

- There were three options presented for this corridor:
 - Option A Make no changes and restripe the road as currently configured after pavement rehabilitation.
 - Option B Update and extend the existing bike lanes while preserving on-street parking on just one side.
 - Option C Restripe to add bike lanes with painted buffers and eliminate onstreet parking for the entire length between 59th Avenue and 51st Avenue.

DECISION

Option A was selected – Once the street is rehabilitated with a slurry seal, Campbell Avenue will be restriped as currently configured. There will be no changes to the areas in which on-street parking is currently allowed.

WHAT'S NEXT

- The 2025 paving project schedule is not yet final, but this segment of Campbell Avenue will receive treatment this year with striping to follow.
