

PROJECT UPDATE – March 2025 Roosevelt Street from 15th Avenue to 7th Avenue

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while considering proposed changes to the section of Roosevelt Street between 15th Avenue and 7th Avenue.

From mid-2023 through January 2025, the department hosted a public meeting and conducted additional outreach on potential options for restriping Roosevelt Street after it is resurfaced. The input gathered from that outreach effort and engineering judgment were taken into consideration as department staff selected the final design.

PROJECT DETAILS

- There were two options presented for this corridor:
 - Option A – Make no changes and restripe the road as currently configured after resurfacing.
 - Option B – Restripe wider bike lanes along Roosevelt Street. This option would result in the removal of on-street parking throughout the entire corridor.

DECISION

Option A was selected – Once the street is rehabilitated with a surface treatment, Roosevelt Street will be restriped as currently configured. There will not be any changes to the areas in which on-street parking is currently allowed.

WHAT'S NEXT

- The 2025 street rehabilitation schedule is not yet final, but this segment of Roosevelt Street will receive a resurfacing treatment this year with striping to follow.
