

Phoenix Airport Wins Grant for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

For several years Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport has been a recipient of the Federal Aviation Administration's Voluntary Airport Low Emission (VALE) environmental grant to reduce emissions at the airport by developing electric charging infrastructure. As part of a recently received grant, 12 electric charging stations were installed around Terminal 3 and 4 for use by tenant airlines. Southwest Airlines replaced an additional 12 aircraft pushbacks and United Airlines replaced 19 bag tractors, bringing the total to 101 GSE converted to electric due to the airport receiving the grants. Best of all, these conversions from diesel-powered GSE to electric has resulted in a reduction of investing more accessible to all investors. With \$7.4 trillion in assets under management, Blackrock is focusing on portfolios that integrate sustainability criteria. With the huge influence they have, will this cause others alike to follow? DID YOU KNOW?

In 2019, the City of Phoenix invested over \$110 million in climate-related projects. These include LED streetlight replacements, transportation improvements, tree planting and maintenance (over 4,500 trees were planted on City land in 2019), as well as investments in our biogas, recycling, and compost facilities.

Phoenix Celebrates Fair Housing Month

April is Fair Housing Month, where we celebrate accomplishments and develop goals in fair housing. Great, right?! But what does fair housing have to do with the environment? More than you might think! Access to various transportation amenities, shorter trips to work and services that reduce transportation costs and environmental burdens should be available to all, not just to people in certain neighborhoods. Additionally, energy costs increase as housing ages, yet newer housing is less likely to be affordable. The city of Phoenix is taking steps to make housing fair to it's citizens, as well as the environment. In partnership with APS, Phoenix is adding solar to the roofs of over 12 multi-housing units where each resident will receive a \$15 credit each month on their energy bill. These are a few reasons ensuring effective housing choice for persons of all races, ethnicities, ages, and incomes is part of our commitment to a sustainable environment in the City of Phoenix!
